

TOUR #824 – Mokelumne River Rendezvous - November 2 2024

TOUR DATE: SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2024

TIME: 7:40 - 9:30 a.m.

DESCRIPTION: Take a light morning hike along the lower Mokelumne River as it spills from Camanche Dam. Birding experts Liz West and Joanne Katanic will share their knowledge about the local landscape and help you scout 35+ species including bluebirds, night herons, several woodpecker species, mergansers, Osprey and other raptors. As an added treat, keep an eye out for spawning salmon as they complete their journey from the Pacific Ocean!

DIRECTIONS TO THE TOUR: *IMPORTANT* - This tour takes place on the south side of the Mokelumne River with access from Route 12 on N. Mcintire Road. Mcintire Road is located between the towns of Clements and Wallace on Route 12. Google Maps may send you to the North side of the river by mistake.

INSTRUCTIONS: Once you have checked-in with your guides, you will walk up to a mile or two over uneven terrain. Wearing layers and good quality footwear are recommended.

DRIVE TIME: Drive time from Hutchins Street Square in Lodi, California to this tour is approximately 20 minutes.

LANDS PASS: No lands pas sis required for this tour.

TRANSPORTATION: You will drive your own vehicle

CHECK-IN: Meet your guides at the entrance to the Mokelumne River Day Use parking lot at 7:30 a.m. Watch for the entrance hut on your left.

NOTE: Do not follow Google Maps directions to this tour. It will take you to the north side of the river by mistake.
