

**TOUR #2624 - Crane Fly-In WER North Unit #2 - November 2, 2024**

**TOUR DATE:** SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2024

**TIME:** 5:15-6:30 p.m.

**DESCRIPTION:** This tour has all the excitement of the other fly-in tours in the area, but visitors will be able to view the Sandhill Cranes (and other birds) from the comfort of a viewing shelter. Seating is provided and maps, charts, and pictorials are on display. Also, visitors will be treated to a presentation by Department of Fish and Wildlife docents. The Woodbridge Ecological Reserve North Unit is generally closed to the public, so it is not uncommon for the cranes to settle in up close and personal.

**DIRECTIONS TO THE TOUR:** Drive west from Interstate 5 on Woodbridge Road for 2 miles. Look for the Woodbridge Ecological Reserve NORTH sign on your right.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** After check-in, your guide will lead you on a gravel road to the shelter. Park your car with headlights facing away from the water. Please stay in the shelter during the tour except for using the toilets.

**DRIVE TIME:** Drive time from Hutchins Street Square in Lodi, CA is 20 minutes.

**LANDS PASS:** All participants are required to carry a current Lands Pass, fishing or hunting license. Go to <https://www.wildlife.ca.gov/licensing/lands-pass> for more information about how to purchase a Lands Pass. You will be required to show your pass or license at that time. **TRANSPORTATION:** You will drive your own vehicle.

**CHECK-IN:** Check in with your guide at the Woodbridge Ecological Reserve NORTH UNIT parking lot at 4:55 p.m.

**NOTE:** Binoculars or a spotting scope will be helpful.
