TOUR #825 - Bird Walk Through the Lodi Lake Nature Area #1 - November 8, 2025

TOUR DATE: SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2025

TOUR TIME: 6:45 - 8:45 a.m.

DESCRIPTION: This tour is for all skill levels. Bring your binoculars and enjoy a leisurely walk on flat ground through the old growth riparian habitat on the Lodi Lake Nature Trail with a local birding expert. Learn the basics or hone your skills in identifying the many birds that reside in or frequent this outstanding area, which is also home to other species, including deer, beaver, fox, possums, and turtles. This gem of a habitat is minutes away from the Festival.

DIRECTIONS: Drive west on Oak Street (North side of Hutchins Street Square) to Ham Lane and turn right. Proceed to Turner Road and turn left. Then drive a block to Lodi Lake. Meet your guides at 1026 Laurel at 710 a.m. (The first street east of the entrance to Lodi Lake.) There is a fee for parking in the parking lot or you may park for free on the street.

INSTRUCTIONS: Be prepared to walk 2 or more miles. Binoculars are a good idea or a light spotting scope.

DRIVE TIME: Drive time from Hutchins Street Square in Lodi, California to this tour is approximately 6 minutes.

LANDS PASS: No Lands Pass is required for this tour.

TRANSPORTATION: You will drive your won vehicle.

CHECK-IN: This tour begins and ends at 1026 Laurel Avenue, east of the park entrance. Meet your tour guide there at 6:30 a.m.

NOTE: Park on the street or pay \$10.00 for parking onsite.
