

TOUR #3425 - Eagles and Their Environment by Boat #2 - November 9, 2025

TOUR DATE: SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2025

TIME: 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. (**Note:** Drive time is included.)

DESCRIPTION: This is the festival's most popular tour. Enjoy your drive through the Sierra foothills to Pardee Reservoir, where you will board a boat with East Bay Municipal Utility District naturalists and biologists. They will take you around the reservoir (which is closed to the public this time of year) to see early arriving Golden and Bald Eagles, as well as other raptors, including Osprey, that frequent the area. This boat tour also offers uncommon bird species not seen on other tours, including loons, grebes, mergansers, and Bufflehead Ducks. In years past, bobcats, deer and other mammals have been spotted. Dress for the weather and bring your binoculars!

DIRECTIONS: Begin your tour at Hutchins Street Square (125 S. Hutchins Street, Lodi) at the bus on Oak Street.

INSTRUCTIONS: Proceed from the bus to the boat launch area. Look for the EBMUD patio boat at the dock area. Check-in with your guide at the dock.

DRIVE TIME: Drive time from Hutchins Street Square in Lodi, California to the Pardee Lake tour location is about 45 minutes.

LANDS PASS: No Lands Pass is required for this tour.

TRANSPORTATION: A 20 passenger bus will transport customers from Hutchins Street Square to Pardee Lake. EBMUD will provide the boat for the tour.

CHECK-IN: Check-in with your guide at the dock by 7:40 a.m.

NOTE: Binoculars will be helpful. Bring snacks and water is desired. Dress in layers
